Competition Format

- 1) The Dragon Boat Race is open to all. Previous experience of Dragon Boat Racing is not necessary to enter a crew but all crew members **MUST BE WATER COMPETENT AND ABLE TO SWIM AT LEAST 50M IN LIGHT CLOTHING**. Competitors under 18 years must supply parental consent in writing to the Race Organisers and all competitors must be 11 years or over. All competitors must wear a buoyancy aid (provided by the event organisers) and be entered on the Crew List they are racing for, to validate their public liability insurance cover.
- 2) Equipment - All boats, necessary equipment for racing and buoyancy vests are supplied.
- 3) Race Results - All race results, apart from the semi-finals and final, will be based on times. Each crew will receive three races, weather permitting, and their fastest two times will count. The crews with the fastest times go through to the semi-finals. From the semi-finals, the winning crews and the fastest loser(s) will proceed to the Grand Final in three boat races.
- 4) Boats & Race Course - Each crew will get the opportunity to race in a different boat and racing lane in each heat to ensure complete fairness. The race distance will be approximately 200m.

- 6) Entry fee of £100 per boat paid prior to racing. Entries Close 5pm on Friday, 25 August 2023.
